Are you a local author or illustrator with a book published in the last three years looking for opportunities to share your work with others? If so, we invite you to join us for Baldwin's Bibliophile Bonanza, our first ever Local Author Fair celebrating writers and illustrators living in our area.

When is the event?

Saturday, November 9 from 2:00 to 400 p.m. at the Baldwin Public Library, 300 West Merrill Street, Birmingham MI 48009.

Who can participate?

All local authors and illustrators are encouraged to apply but preference will be given to those residing in our service area: Birmingham, Beverly Hills, Bloomfield Hills, and Bingham Farms. Self published authors are welcome. Authors or illustrators must have a book published in the last three years. Authors or illustrators writing for children, teens, and adults as well as authors of fiction, non-fiction, and poetry are welcome to apply.

What is the space like at this event?

Each participant will have one small table (5 ft by 18 in) to display and promote their book(s) and two chairs.

Can I sell my book at the event?

Yes! Authors are responsible for supplying their own books to sell. Wifi is available for online book sales. Library staff will not be available to help with sales. You are responsible for providing change and/or a credit card app for purchases. The books sold must be offered at or below retail price. You may, within reason, bring other books you have written or illustrated to sell in addition to the book selected for the author fair.

How do I apply?

Apply online at baldwinlib.org/youth and click on the application link. You must submit a physical copy of your book to the Baldwin Public Library. Drop off books in person or mail it to 300 W. Merrill St. Birmingham, MI 48009 c/o Alyssa Gudenburr. We may or may not add your book to our collection and it will not be returned to you. The application period is August 1 through August 31. The online application must be filled out and the physical book received at the Library by Saturday, August 31. Due to limited space, we cannot accept everyone who applies. We will review all applications and contact all participants by October 1st with regards to their application status.
